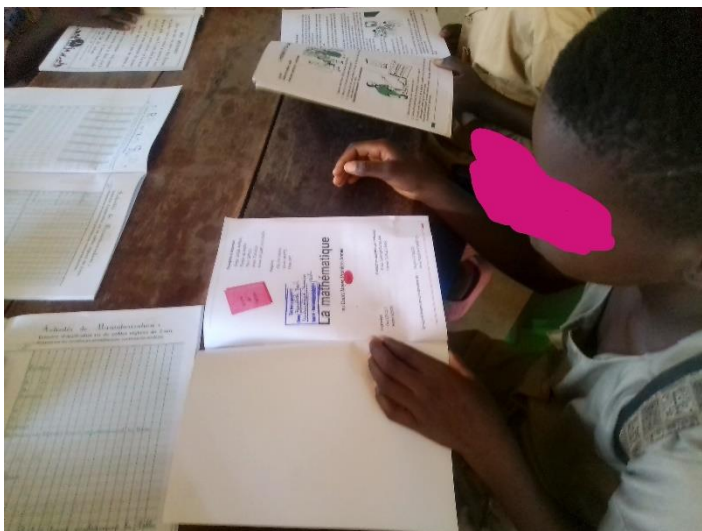
## 2. Benefizkonzert in Burgdorf

On June 20, 2025, a concert by the ecumenical band Salt'nSoul took place at the St. Pankratius Parish in Burgdorf. The musical service had the theme "One World," and the Yaoui e.V. project was presented during the service. Admission was free, and the congregation donated a total of €300 to our association. A heartfelt thank you to the Burgdorf congregation and a welcome to the three new members.



### 3. Information on the current status of the projects

The new schoolbooks purchased locally with your support have been stamped with the donors' names. We received many photos from Yaoui of the stamped and named books. We will also contact the individual donors personally soon and provide proof of the allocated books. Here's an example of what such a stamp with the donor's name looks like in the book:





We've also received new information regarding the building upgrades and the installation of the PV system. The PV system has been installed, and the school is now awaiting the delivery and installation of the electricity meter. This will be mounted at the rear of the library. Once the meter is installed, the system can be put into operation, supplying the school with electricity in this way, instead of using generators as before. We don't yet have photos of the finished PV system, but we have received some photos of the construction materials used.

Since the overall costs for the repair and installation of the PV system were lower overall, the long-awaited printer was purchased with the remaining funds provided by our association. The funds originally intended for this purpose can now be used locally for other purposes for the benefit of the school.

We are also pleased to announce that the gym bags voted on by the general assembly were made in Yaoui and handed over to the students, who were very pleased.
